Mary D'Arcy O'Connell will teach four groups of 5 riders (at approximately the same ability level) in up to two-hour sessions on Saturday and Sunday. Private dressage lessons (\$100/45-minute session) with Mary are available on Friday, 6/23, on a first-come, first-served basis. The clinic is open to all Area V Adult Riders. ### **ABOUT THE CLINICIAN**

A native of Dublin, Ireland, Mary D'Arcy O'Connell was an active participant in Pony Club. She obtained her equestrian teaching qualifications as a protégé of European Show-Jumping Champion Iris Kellett, and became a British Horse Society Instructor (BHSI). She competed successfully for many years in show jumping, eventing, and dressage. To further her education, she studied with top-class trainers in Germany, Italy, Switzerland, Great Britain, and the United States.

For more than 35 years Mary has coached riders for competitions all over the world including all major European events (Badminton, Burghley, and the European Championships, among others), as well as Olympic Games in Atlanta, Sydney, and Athens. She coached five European eventing medalists, as well as the gold medal winning team at the 1995 European Young Riders Three-Day Event Championships in Germany. She officially became the Irish Team Eventing coach from 2000 to 2005 including the Sydney 2000 and Athens 2004 Olympic Games, the European Championships and World Equestrian Games. In the US, she has coached dressage riders to their USDF bronze, silver and gold medals.

Mary is an ICP faculty member, committee member and assessor. She currently trains horses and riders, from novice to advanced, for competitions in eventing, show jumping, and dressage, and she travels frequently as a clinician.

**USEF Rules for Eventing** Appendix 3, Section 4.4: **AMATEUR RIDER (AR)** - The following may participate in Eventing competitions as an Amateur. **A)** Any competitor in possession of a valid Amateur Card issued by the USEF, or **B)** Any Senior USEA member who competes in the Training, Novice or Beginner Novice level who meets the requirements of Federation GR1306. Individuals declaring such status must present, upon demand, an audited financial statement in support of the claim of eligibility; failure to do so will be deemed a violation. Misrepresentation of eligibility under this provision will subject an individual to disciplinary action under GR1307.6, GR1307.8, GR1308.3 and Chapter 6. Amateur certification under this provision is valid for Eventing competitions only and does not confer Amateur status for participation in any other Breed or Discipline.
