In consideration of receiving permission to enter upon, use and enjoy the premises known as Marvin Savage Farm, in Weatherford, Parker County, Texas, from time to time, the receipt of such permission being hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of receiving permission to participate either as an owner, trainer, instructor, student, attendant, participant, or in any other capacity, in any equestrian activity, such as, showing, giving lessons, taking lessons, training, riding, or using equestrian facilities in any fashion, the undersigned hereby releases Marvin Savage Farm and any related or affiliated company or person, and their respective officers, directors, agents, and employees, of and from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever, arising out of or related to any loss, damage or injury, including death, that may be sustained by the undersigned or to any minor child that is the responsibility of the undersigned, or to any property or animal belonging to the undersigned, while in, on, or upon said premises, or any premises leased to, owned by, or under the control or supervision of any of the above-named entities or individuals. The undersigned also gives permission for themselves, family members, friends, or affiliates to be treated by a physician or a hospital on an emergency basis.

### **Mary D'Arcy O'Connell USEA ICP Level IV Certified Instructor. BHSI.**

A native of Dublin, Ireland, Mary was an active participant in Pony Club. She obtained her equestrian teaching qualifications as a protege of European Show-Jumping Champion Iris Kellett, and became a British Horse Society Instructor (BHSI). She competed successfully for many years in show jumping, eventing and dressage. To further her education, she studied with top-class trainers in Germany, Italy, Switzerland, Great Britain and the United States.

For more than 35 years Mary has coached riders for competitions all over the world including Badminton, Burghley, and all major European events, as well as the European Championships, and the Atlanta, Sydney and Athens Olympic Games. She coached five European eventing medalists, as well as the gold medal winning team at the 1995 European Young Riders Three-Day Event Championships in Germany. She officially became the Irish Team Eventing coach from 2000 to 2005 including the Sydney 2000 and Athens 2004 Olympic Games, the European Championships and World Equestrian Games. In the US, she has coached dressage riders to their USDF bronze, silver and gold medals.

Mary is an ICP faculty member, committee member and assessor. She currently trains horses and riders, from beginner novice to advanced, for competitions in eventing, show jumping, and dressage, and she travels frequently as a clinician.
