ATTIRE & TACK - be comfortable - be safe.

REQUIRED: (1) ASTM-approved helmet while mounted; (2) Neg. Coggins; (3) signed Release Waiver

ENTRY FEE - -\$5 to enter and ride per class per ride - *pay at the In-Gate plus \$5 for each re-ride of the same class*

- * \$50 for unlimited rides for one rider on any number of horses

* *Unlimited: instant re-rides on request; limit 2 re-rides per horse per class, unless Ring Steward ok's more.*

-Stabling: \$25/night-initial bedding included; additional shavings \$10/bag
 \$25 refundable stall cleaning deposit

-RV hook-ups \$35 per night

GATE ENTRY

When each class is called, check in and pay at the In-Gate to get on the ride list.

Have lots of \$5 bills in your pocket! (Or show your badge if you buy unlimited rides.)

You may enter any class until the last call for riders is made for that class. Just check-in and pay at the In-Gate as soon as you decide, so the steward adds you to the ride list.

You may ride any class as many times as you wish, for \$5 per ride. You may add a re-ride after your first ride, or pay for 2+ rides when you enter. Want to ride back-to-back? Messed up and want a do-over? Quick re-rides! And multiple re-rides! Stewards will fairly add rides into the order of go.

SCORING: Clear round = no knockdowns or refusals = gets a ribbon. Three refusals is elimination.

There is no other scoring. Any gait permitted. You may re-ride an elimination round for \$5.

(Show Management & Ring Steward reserve the right to stop/bar rounds, in the interests of safety.)

2-a, 2-b	18" - 1 st jump cross-rail	5-a, 5-b	2'6"	8-a, 8-b, 8-c	3'3"
3-a, 3-b	2'	6-a, 6-b, 6-c	2'9"	9-a, 9-b, 9-c	3'6"

Each height-level has 2 classes: Course A and Course B. Add Course C for higher classes. HEIGHTS are as CONSISTENT as possible for EVERY jump in the class, with an inviting first jump.

Course A: Basic for the height. 2' and under has 6-8 jumps, no combinations.

Course B: More turns. For 2'+ height, at least one combination with one or two strides. 8-10 jumps.

Course C (2'9"+): May have one or more: skinny; corner; rollback turn(s); angle approach; etc.

JUMP NOTES: All classes are in one ring, using different routes over a variety of jumps. Warm-up ring close by. Flower decoration, except Pile O' Poles. Narrow wings and no wings. No jump #'s. Courses will be posted at warmup.
